- The bidder shall carry out maintenance services on NVR machines in line with the manufacturer's specification and upgrading of the system when the need arises as the technological requirements and development may demand.
- The bidder shall provide a twenty four (24) hour call out in the event of emergency with competent technicians who are familiar with the site thereby guaranteeing a response time not exceeding five (5) hours during normal working hours and ten (10) hours after working hours.
- The bidder will be responsible for the provision of preventative maintenance service on a
 yearly basis at the Department of Community Safety offices. The bidder will be required to
 respond to system faults on unlimited call outs. The bid will be evaluated using yearly fee as
 per the pricing schedule.
- The bidder will also be responsible for supply and installation of new equipment and parts on an ad hoc basis at the Department of Community Safety office subject to Department of Community Safety approval.

3. Quotation Qualification Criteria

3.1 Compliance Requirements:

The supplier[s] or service provider[s] should comply and take note of the following minimum requirement:

- Certified copy/ copies must be certified by a Commissioner of Oaths from the South African Police Service(SAPS) or South African Post Office(SAPO) and must be date stamped not longer than six (06) months prior to the closure of this RFQ;

In terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2000) as amended and 2017 Regulations thereto points for B-BBEE status is subject to application when bids are evaluated on price based on the 80/20 preference point system. Criteria relating to functionality, price and contract participation will be used for the evaluation of proposals.

4.1.2 Evaluation Criteria on Functionality

Supply Chain Management will first perform compliance check to assess completeness of the submitted proposal. Due to the technical nature of this contract, it will be necessary to establish the technical capabilities of bidders hence the functionality/technical assessment. Bidders are therefore advised that the technical assessment will be used as pre-qualifying criteria.
